



## **WATERFRONT LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FORMAL PROCESS FOR SUBMITTING A PROTEST**

**May 2018**

As a part of the LID formation process, property owners in the proposed LID can submit a formal protest to the LID formation. The formal protest period began on May 21, 2018, when the Seattle City Council passed the Resolution of Intent to Form the Waterfront LID. In the coming weeks, property owners will receive a letter with their special benefit, preliminary assessment amount, hearing information, and information on how to protest the LID formation.

To submit a protest, property owners must write a letter with the following information: full name, parcel number, the words "I protest" and an original signature from the property owner(s) of record.

Protests can either be mailed to PO Box 94607, Seattle, WA 98124-6907 or provided as a written protest at the public hearing. Email is not an accepted format for written protest. Property owners may use a proxy at the public hearing to submit a protest. Information about the public hearing is available on the [LID webpage](#).
