ALASKAN WAY, PROMENADE, AND OVERLOOK WALK

Final Environmental Impact Statement

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) and the Office of the Waterfront have released the Final Environmental Impact Statement (Final EIS) for the Alaskan Way, Promenade, and Overlook Walk projects (AWPOW). AWPOW includes most of the Waterfront Seattle improvements. Other elements, such as the public piers, will undergo appropriate environmental review separately as design progresses.

The Final EIS evaluates the potential impacts to the natural and built environment that could result from AWPOW and responds to the public comments submitted during the comment periods for the AWPOW Draft EIS and Supplemental Draft EIS. Consistent with the Washington State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA), there is no comment period accompanying the release of a Final EIS.
