PIER 62, NEW IN BLUE AND UTILITIES TOO

A rebuilt Pier 62 will be the first park space we re-open to the public; coming soon in late 2019. To reach that goal, we started by removing the existing pier. Check out the time-lapse video below to see how it all happened. Reconstruction of the new pier begins towards the end of summer!

Construction of critical utilities is also underway, in preparation for the demolition of the Alaskan Way Viaduct. We worked hard to complete utility work at Union and University streets ahead of the summer season to make more room for summer adventures.

In May, Seattle City Council passed a Resolution of Intent to Form a proposed Waterfront Local Improvement District (LID). Over the course of 2018, Council will consider whether to form the proposed LID. The City is seeking public comments on the proposed LID.
