- The [Seawall Project](#) will complete the second season of construction in June as it continues building the foundation of the waterfront.
- Pike Place Market will begin constructing [MarketFront](#), a major first step toward a new connection between Pike Place Market and the waterfront.
- This summer, Friends of Waterfront Seattle will launch [Hot Spot](#), a temporary pavilion in Waterfront Park designed by graduate students at the UW's School of Architecture. In the meantime, be sure to visit their [Waterfront Space](#) project showroom on Western Avenue!



- Waterfront Seattle will continue [design and delivery of the first projects](#) that will be constructed, including the new Alaskan Way and Elliott Way, public promenade and key east-west connections.
