ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW UPDATE


The City of Seattle will complete a Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Alaskan Way, Promenade, and Overlook Walk (AWPOW). The Supplemental Draft EIS is expected to be released in spring 2016. It will be accompanied by a 30-day public comment period, including a public meeting and opportunities to comment online. PIKE PLACE MARKETFRONT CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Pike Place Market's [MarketFront](#) is an important partner project because it is building the first piece of the connection from the Market to the waterfront. The project will convert the parking lot on Western Avenue into a thriving market space for farmers, craftspeople and artisans, and will include public parking, low-income housing and more. We celebrated the MarketFront groundbreaking in June 2015, and construction is scheduled to be complete by early 2017. Currently, crews are drilling piers and support beams to form the foundation, which they anticipate will continue through December.
