Elliott Bay Seawall Project reaches major milestones

The Elliott Bay Seawall Project has reached several major milestones in November, including the release of the [Draft Environmental Impact Statement \(EIS\)](#), the selection of Mortenson/Manson as the General Contractor/Construction Manager (GC/CM) for seawall construction, and voter approval of a \$290 million bond measure to fund the seawall replacement.
