

### **Waterfront Seattle receives national recognition**

Waterfront Seattle recently received national recognition from the American Planning Association for excellence in planning. The project has been awarded the National Planning Achievement Award for Urban Design for the Waterfront Seattle Concept Design and Framework Plan.

Developed through extensive public engagement over the past two years, this plan establishes the City's vision for creating more than 26 city blocks of new public space with the removal of the Alaskan Way Viaduct and reconnecting central Seattle to Elliott Bay.
